Parents and Carers

- Support the school's ethos, vision and core Christian values for the education and well-being of their child.
- Inform the school promptly of any issues which are likely to affect the child's work or behaviour.
- Support the behaviour and anti-bullying policies of the school.

- Weekly MyMaths activity (Y2)
- Times Table Practice (Y2)
- Please note that sometimes homework may be set for specific children if they need support in a particular area.
