Happy Homework Club and CGP study revision/homework

Dear Parents and Carers,

During the Spring Term we will be running our usual Happy Homework club for all of the Year 6 children and encourage that your child joins us for all of these sessions. This is due to start the week beginning Monday 9th January 2023 and will take place on the following dates, running from 3:20pm – 4:15pm. Squash and biscuits will be provided for the children. Mrs Methley, Mrs Hughes and myself will run the Happy Homework sessions.

As a school, we will be purchasing CGP study, revision and question books to help the children revise for their upcoming SATS papers. Before the children break up for the Christmas holidays, they will be bringing back home with them:

- A Maths Revision Guide
- A Maths Targeted Question book
- A Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling 10-Minute Weekly Workout book
- A Maths 10-Minute Weekly Workout book
- A Reading 10-Minute Weekly Workout book

For homework each week across the Spring term, your child will be asked to complete one 10-Minute Weekly Workout in Maths, Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling and Reading (a total of 30 minutes) and two question pages of their Maths Targeted Question book (15/20 minutes). I suggest that the children try to complete the pages set and answer every question, even if it does take them slightly longer than the dedicated timings per task; however, understandably, if they are spending much longer on each task, then they should just complete what they can. This homework will be **replacing** the MyMaths set each week. The Topic and Reading homework grid will also become **optional**. All of the workbooks the children can keep, **apart from the Maths Revision Guide** as these will need to be collected back again at the end of the academic year.

In the inside cover of each workbook, I will include a sticker each week that states the exact pages your child will need to complete and the Happy Homework date that the books need to come back into school. There is no expectation for the children to complete the first set of homework over the Christmas holidays (the due date for these is not until Monday 9th January) but it is a good chance for them to familiarise themselves with the books.

If you **do not wish** for your child to walk home alone after Happy Homework club on the dates specified at the top of this letter, then please contact the school office.

If, for any reason, you **do not** wish for your child to attend Happy Homework club, or if you have any questions at all regarding this homework, then please do not hesitate to contact the school office at your earliest convenience, so that they can make an appointment for you to speak with me.
