NSPCC - Safer Internet Parent Workshop

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are very pleased to inform you that we have scheduled a Safer Internet Parent Workshop, run by the NSPCC, on **Tuesday 7th February 2023 from 3:30-4:30pm in the school hall.**

With the right E-Safety knowledge, we can help children better understand the dangers of releasing personal information, as well as recognise unethical behaviours or prevent cyberbullying.

The workshop includes some core content, which consists of general online safety information for parents/carers and includes:

- What children and young people are doing online
- Parental/carer concerns
- What the risks are for young people in terms of what they see, do and who they meet online
- How to manage these risks as a parent/carer
- Sources of help/support.

In addition, content will be provided on the following topics:

- Online friendships
- Parental controls
- Persuasive design an screen time vs screen use
- Social media

We hope that as many of you will be able to join us as possible, so you can be supported with online safety information and guidance. You are more than welcome to wait on the school playground until the 3:30pm start. If needed, your child(ren) can wait in a classroom with other children and supervision from a member of staff until the workshop is over.
