### NEU Strike Action

Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my letter dated 25<sup>th</sup> January 2023 regarding proposed upcoming NEU strike action on the 1<sup>st</sup> of February, I am writing to update you on our arrangements for Wednesday.

Classes closed due to **strike action** are:

- Y2 Full day closure
- Y3 Morning closure only (see below)
- Y6 Full Day closure

Year 3 only - there are two times available for arrival for the afternoon session. Please either arrive at 12:30pm if your child would like a school lunch. You will need to e-mail your child's lunch choice by 9am on Wednesday. We are happy to take orders before this day.

We are on week 2 of the school menu <https://stpaulsprimaryyork.com/parents-carers/school-meals-snacks/>. Alternatively, if no lunch is required please arrive at 1:10pm. Please use the front entrance on St Paul's Terrace and arrive at either 12:30pm or 1:10pm.

### Other Classes

There may be other factors on the morning of the strike which could affect additional classes. We will therefore assess to ensure adequate staffing on the morning of the 1<sup>st</sup> of February and issue an update before 8am by email. ### Free school meals Y2 & Y6

If your child is eligible to either Key Stage 1 Universal Free School Meals or Free School Meals you will be able to collect a pack-up (the Wednesday option is a tuna sandwich) from school from 10:30am. Please email the school office before 9am on Wednesday the 1<sup>st</sup> of February to order. We are happy to take orders before this day.

### Students with an EHCP

School will be open for all pupils who have an EHCP if you wish your child to attend. They will be able to work with support staff and will be supervised by trusted adults during the day. Please let school know as soon as you are able and by Tuesday at 3:30pm if you would like your child to attend.
