### NEU Strike Action

Dear Parents and Carers,

Further to my letter dated 21<sup>st</sup> February 2023 regarding proposed upcoming NEU strike action on the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of March, I am writing to update you on our arrangements for Wednesday and Thursday.

Classes closed due to **strike action** are:

- **Year 2, full day closure Wednesday and full day closure Thursday**
- **Year 3, half day closure Wednesday morning, open Wednesday afternoon and open Thursday**
- **Year 6, full day closure Wednesday and half day closure Thursday morning, open Thursday afternoon**

Morning closure only - there are two times available for arrival for the afternoon session. Please either arrive at 12:30pm if your child would like a school lunch. You will need to e-mail your child's lunch choice by 9am on Wednesday (Class 3) and Thursday (Class 6). We are happy to take orders before this day.

Please use the front entrance on St Paul's Terrace and arrive at either 12:30pm or 1:10pm.

#### **Other Classes**

There may be other factors on the mornings of the strike which could affect additional classes. We will therefore assess to ensure adequate staffing on the mornings of both the 15<sup>th</sup> and 16<sup>th</sup> of March and issue an update before 8am each morning by email.

#### **Free school meals**

If your child is eligible to either Key Stage 1 Universal Free School Meals or Free School Meals you will be able to collect a pack-up (the Wednesday option is a tuna sandwich and the Thursday a ham sandwich) from school from 10:30am. Please email the school office before 9am on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March to order. We are happy to take orders before this day.

#### **Students with an EHCP**

School will be open for all pupils who have an EHCP if you wish your child to attend. They will be able to work with support staff and will be supervised by trusted adults during the day. Please let school know as soon as you are able and by Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> March at 9am if you would like your child to attend.
