YEAR 6 RESIDENTIAL – CARLTON LODGE, JUNE 2023. MEETING, ACCOMMODATION UPDATE, CLOTHING AND KIT REQUIREMENTS.

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware, we have made a booking for a residential trip during the Summer Term and the details are as follows:

- Venue:** Carlton Lodge - Thirsk

- Date:** Monday 26th to Wednesday 28th June 2023 (2 night residential)
- Depart:** Monday 26th June 2023 at approximately 10.30am (TBC)
- Return:** Wednesday 28th June 2023 at approximately 2pm (TBC)

Accommodation Arrangements: The children will be staying in dormitories in 'The Sports Building' (boys & girls separate) on site within the activity centre, of which we will have sole occupancy during our visit. The Sports Building is a self-contained, multi-purpose building. In addition to sports and changing facilities, the ground floor features a kitchen and a lounge/dining room. The first floor has dormitory accommodation for 36 people in 5 rooms. **We have heard that we will also have sole occupancy over a brand new accommodation building that will have opened by the time we visit Carlton Lodge, allowing the children to be split into smaller groups (again, boys and girls separate). More details of this to follow.** All meals are included (breakfast, packed lunch, hot evening meal). Mrs Severn, Mrs Hann, Mrs Adams and Mrs Lynch will accompany the children.

Carlton Lodge meeting for parents and carers: We have arranged for Judith Worrall, the business and booking manager at Carlton lodge, to hold a residential meeting with Class 6 parents and carers on **Thursday 4th May, 4:00 – 5:00pm**. We hope as many of you can attend as possible. However, please be rest assured that the presentation slides from the meeting can be shared with you if you are unable to make this date. Our itinerary is yet to be finalised but this should be shared with you during this meeting.

Clothing and Kit Requirements: To ensure the comfort and safety of the children during activity sessions, the centre recommends that your child brings the following kit:

- Waterproof coat
- Waterproof trousers
- Warm jumpers/fleeces
- Old jogging bottoms for water sports
- Jogging bottoms (for dry activities)
- Shorts
- Plenty of t-shirts
- Plenty of spare socks and underwear

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- Hat and gloves
- Sun hat
- 1 towel for water sports and a towel for the dormitory
- 1 old pair of trainers for water sports
- 1 pair of trainers for dry activities
- Wellies
- Plenty of hair bobbles
- A torch
- Sun cream
- Black bin liner labelled with name for wet clothes

Jeans are not recommended for activities due to poor thermal properties. This list is **only for activities; your child will need extra clothes for their free time and also night wear.**

A drying room is available for us and the heaters are timed to come on overnight and should dry clothes if they are properly stored.

Just another reminder to ensure that all clothing is **clearly named.**

All specialised equipment will be provided by the centre.
