This is a chance to learn about Tudor medicine and how illness and ailments were treated hundreds of years ago.

Venue:	Barley Hall, York.
Dates:	Class 5 – Monday 5th June 2023 Class 6 – Wednesday 7th June 2023
Leaving at:	10:00am approx.
Returning at:	1:30pm approx.
Lunch arrangements:	Packed lunch – child's own or provided by school, see options on the next page.
Clothing required:	School uniform/Outdoor shoes/Waterproof coat.
We will travel by:	Walking
Cost:	£6.00 per child (Please pay using Parent Pay by 19th May 2023). This cost is to cover entry to the museum and for a workshop. Children who are in receipt of additional funding will have this contribution paid by school.

Whilst we offer as much funding as is possible towards our educational visits and enrichment opportunities, we, unfortunately, do not have the available financial resources to fund the full amount of this event.
