City of York Council Pedestrian Training

A practical training course in basic road awareness and crossing roads in a safe manner has been arranged with City of York Council Road Safety Team.

Pedestrian Training is carried out during school hours on risk assessed roads near the school. The course comprises of two 1 ½ hour sessions made up of theory and practical sessions. Pupils are taken outside in supervised groups and follow a simple lesson plan for crossing roads and staying safe as a pedestrian. They may also practise using various pedestrian crossing facilities such as zebra crossings, pelican, puffin, and toucan crossings, pedestrian facilities at traffic light controlled junctions and pedestrian islands, depending on the facilities near to the school. Route planning may also be covered if time allows.

Everyone taking part in the training will be required to wear a hi-viz vest which will be supplied. **Training will only be cancelled if the instructors feel it is unsafe to train due to adverse weather conditions. Please ensure your child has clothing appropriate for the forecast weather.**

Completion of the course will not mean that your child is capable of coping with the road environment on their own. This is only the beginning of a long learning process which will continue into adult life. It is essential that you help your child practise what they have learnt on their course.
