National Railway Museum

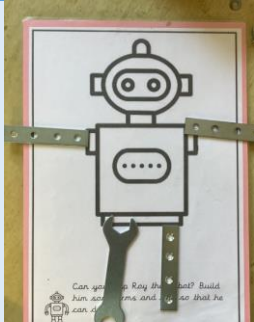
