We learnt all about the different parts of the heart and their functions and even got to feel it for ourselves! Other children did a great job creating their own sketched diagram.



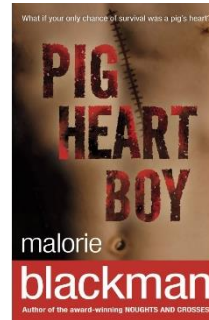
### PE

We have been learning about fitness, conditioning and strength as well as learning new basketball skills this term.



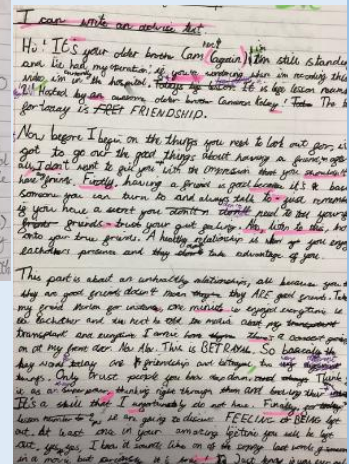
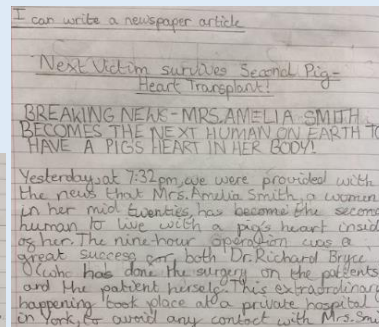
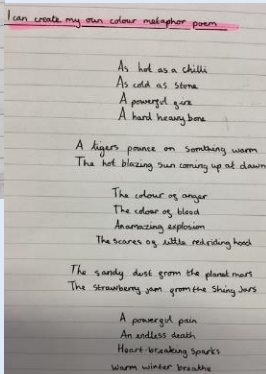
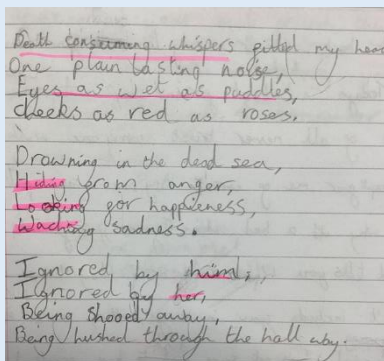
### Class Text

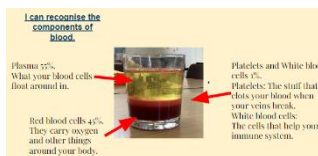
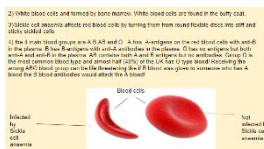
## Amazing Art
