Topic Overview	<p>From window-box gardening, vegetable patches and allotments, to arable and pastoral farms across the country, we use the land around us to provide the food we eat. In this unit, we will be learning about agriculture and the processes involved in sowing, growing and harvesting different crops and foods.</p> <p>Incorporating visits to our own allotment, and local farms, we will learn about seasonality, climate, and how plants are suited to growing in differing conditions and locations. We will explore different animal life cycles, plant reproduction and seed dispersal.</p>
