Write a diary entry or a letter home from an evacuee sent to the countryside during WW2.	Write a message using Morse Code or create your own code, which will enable you to send a secret message.	Radar was first developed by British scientists in WWII. How does it work and what are its modern day uses? Present your findings.
Design and make a periscope. Describe how it worked and why this might be a useful device in war time.	Create a timeline showing the key dates and events of The Great War and World War 2.	Find and follow a war-time recipe.
Shade a world map and create a key to show the countries involved in WW2 and the allied forces. Can you label with significant battles?	Design a propaganda poster to persuade men to enlist/women to serve as land girls.	Create a fact file for one of these significant individuals: Winston Churchill, Emmeline Pankhurst, Wilfred Owen, Alan Turing.
