Lunch arrangements:	<b>In School</b>
Clothing required:	<b>Old clothes, including: long trousers (not jeans), waterproof coat, waterproof trousers (if possible), walking boots or wellies, hat and gloves.</b> Please see below paragraph regarding provision of school uniform for the afternoon.
Cost:	<b>£9.23 per child (Please pay using Parent Pay)</b> <b>Children who are in receipt of additional funding will have this contribution paid by school.</b>
Consent:	<b>We do not require further consent for this trip, as it is an educational visit during the school day which is part of the routine curriculum.</b>

We expect to get quite muddy during our activities and so suitable clothing is essential for the enjoyment of our sessions. Please send your children into school wearing their old clothes. **School uniform and shoes should be sent into school in a named carrier bag so we can change on returning to school.** If you have any questions or concerns regarding this please speak to your child's class teacher.
