As we continue to develop our knowledge and understanding of rural land use, the natural world, and caring for our wildlife and environment, we are very excited to take Class 5 on a day trip to Harewood Estate at the beginning of the second half term. During the trip, the children will be getting hands on, learning about conservation, livestock, and the wildlife and nature areas at Harewood. It will be an outdoor learning day with children participating in activities such as pond dipping, conducting small mammal surveys and also meeting and feeding some of the animals which are reared on the estate.

Lunch arrangements:	Packed lunch - child's own or provided by school, see options on the next page. Please ensure every child has their own water bottle.
Clothing required:	School uniform is not required, we may get a little muddy on this trip. Children should wear long sleeves and long trousers. Hiking boots, wellies or other similar outdoor shoes (if you do not have these, then please wear sturdy trainers which you do mind getting muddy). Sun Hat and sun cream, raincoat depending on the weather. Children will need a backpack that they can carry throughout day with their pack up, water bottle, and waterproof coat.
