### Sports Day!

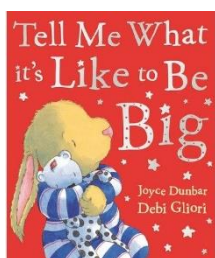
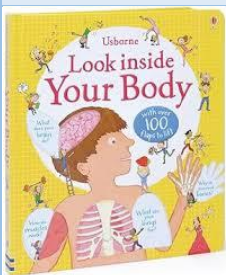
